Comments

David: Direction of travel: Issues and options bring forward. London plan dates are optimistic and depends on who gets elected mayor - will want to look again. In an ideal world local plan woulc come after London plan - but we must ignore that as London plan is evolving document.

Caroline: Why can't our plan fit existing plan?

David: I'm not telling what neighbourhood plan should do.

Caroline: Can we get status of plan to work together with more formal work.

David : Statute of local plan is legal requirement setting down stages . Councillors will make decisions on plan

Howard : Don't hold back - start process keep in mind existing and emerging plans - if significant change then have to be debated and accommodated

Slides Funding: Can get £8k with something viable and ready to fund.

Andre: If you don't spend sensibly have to give it back.

David: No contributions before approval. Inspectors in November?

Di: Can we ask RBK for money? Glen setting up website - sponsor ship? May generate few £100 per year.

David: Inspectors of Bristol to do exam or chartered planners. Bristol may be free? Need to be indpt inspector

Di: Richmond council example ...

Howard: Membership fee?

Di: £5 year

Di: Typos from Duncan 1) Proxy option 2) 20 or 50% too high for quorum. Finance year end April.

AGM within 3 months. Most people don't do this move year end to autumn

All: Sensible year end 31 Dec? Passed

Des: Calendar year makes sense: Need 20 members quorum

Andre: Need quorum at meeting. Need to check what others have.

Howard: 14 here today - suggest 12

Des: but more for an AGM

20 Quorum for AGM and 10 for general committee mtg - suggest - ?
